Acorns PreSchool (Kington St Michael) Report of the Trustees For the Year Ended 31 August 2021

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 August 2021. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The charity works for the public benefit having as its objects the development and education of children and young people in particular by:

- (1) promoting their care and safety;
- (2) promoting their education and promoting parental involvement;
- (3) promoting their health and wellbeing;
- (4) providing services to support them and their families and carers;
- (5) providing services to individuals holding membership of the CIO; and
- (6) furthering the aims of the pre-school learning alliance.

Significant activities

The charity runs as a preschool, delivering care to children aged 2-5 years of age in the local community.

Achievements and performance

Despite the challenges faced by the preschool with the Covid-19 Pandemic, the manager, staff and committee have worked hard to ensure that Acoms continues to provide a high level of childcare in a safe way. The numbers of children registered have continued to rise and the reputation and feedback from parents and children remains very positive.

Public benefit

The trustees have paid due regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit in deciding what activities the charity should undertake. The trustees consider that they have acted in the public benefit.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Financial position

At 31 August 2021 the charity had total funds of £42,939.75.

RESERVES POLICY

The Trustees aim to retain unrestricted reserves to three months of support costs in line with good practice and following the requirements of the Charities Commission. At 31 August 2021 the charity held free cash reserves of £41,362 which is in excess of our policy. Restricted funds at 31 August 2021 were £1,578.

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) registered 15 December 2015.
