Our report for 2019/20 set out how we advertised in that period for new trustees, without success. The trustees in post at the beginning of the year determined that the charity was to be wound up. The trustees published notices advising that the charity was to be would up and its land sold. The trustees received two offers for the land. In tandem with the offers for the land, the trustees received 8 applications from prospective trustees. Given the renewed interest in the charity, the trustees determined that it would be best to recruit additional trustees. We interviewed 7 candidates and appointed 4 trustees. Subsequently, the trustees resolved to reject the offers and to continue to operate the charity with renewed enthusiasm.

The charity has hosted a number of community gardening events. These events are advertised on our notice board on site, as well as on our Facebook group. Friendships are formed and attendees support each other and contribute ideas for how the community garden is managed.

At all times, the trustees have given due regard to guidance issued by the Charity Commission.

We estimate that around 30 volunteer hours were amassed in the period. Volunteers were able to commence the clearance of undergrowth which has taken over the site during covid restrictions. This work is ongoing as we move into the next financial year in April.
