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REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2021

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the period ended 31 March 2021. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The object of the charity is to advance in life and help young people through;

a) The provision of recreational and leisure time activities provided in the interest of social welfare, designed to improve their conditions of life;

b) Providing support and activities which develop their skills, capacities and capabilities to enable them to participate in society as mature and responsible individuals.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

We are currently running outdoor learning programmes for children ages 6 through 13 designed to develop physical agility, problem solving skills and communication. The charity's activities are entered around schools in London and to date the principle focus has been on one school. The outlook for the next 12 months is to:

1. Continue working with Hurlingham Academy and Sands End Community Center

2. Build on the success of the summer camp program supporting the local community

3. Find local support for funding potential new venture with Balcombe CofE Primary school

FINANCIAL REVIEW

During the year the charity received further grant funding from Oak Foundation to continue to enable it to carry out its current activities at the Hurlingham Academy. All of the grant has been recognised within unrestricted funds and the charity carries these funds forward with the purpose of continuing to fund its current programme.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2021

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charitable SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charitables: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charitable preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.

2. TRUSTEES' REMUNERATION AND BENEFITS

There were no trustees' remuneration or other benefits for the year ended 31 March 2021 nor for the year ended 31 March 2020.

Trustees' expenses

During the year the Trustees approved expenses claimed by J T Hicks of £4,800 for costs he incurred on behalf of the charity.
