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REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2021

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 March 2021. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

The charity believes that it has fulfilled its objectives, with the support of grants received. It hopes that the current year provides the services to even a greater number of individuals.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves policy

The trustees aim to keep the reserves of the charity sufficient to cover six months of resource.

The charity currently operates with minimal reserves, with no specific investments other than bank accounts. The trustees will try to increase the level of reserves. It will also, through advertising, social media, increase students into the school. The charity normally has an annual fund raiser in winter term, (Variety Show did not go ahead 2020, due to Covid-19 restrictions).

Variety Show and fund raiser, scheduled for 4th November 2021.

FUTURE PLANS

We have retained a dedicated grant writer, who has already proved to be an asset.

Project currently running.

- -Rock Star Project for advanced teenage students.
- -Youth Band for beginners/intermediate teenage students.
- -Wellbeing for over 55s, offering group session in guitar and ukulele.
- -Breathe Easy Project electronic saxophone group session. Aimed at helping students with breathing difficulties i.e. asthma.

We are looking to secure funding to start a new project, which takes the BMS students/tutors to the wider community. Other schools, care homes etc. We are applying for portable equipment, which will be used to promote the school at outside venues.

We are promoting the school through social media, which includes our website, Facebook, Twitter, and Youtube. Plus, additional advertising for any new projects.

The last year was challenging with covid-19, lockdowns, and restrictions but we are hopeful that the worst is behind us. However, if lockdown were to happen, we have all the I.T. in place to offer virtual tuition.

NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 MARCH 2021

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

All monetary values in the accounts are presented in Sterling and all amounts are rounded to the nearest pound.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

Plant and machinery - 25% on reducing balance

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.
