Music therapy has been increasingly acknowledged as a medium to break down barriers surrounding mental health through sharing the varieties on melody and song, whilst building upon social skills, confidence, self -esteem and communication skills. We received funding to support individual children through music therapy and parents have commented how much the children benefit from the experience. Training room/social space Families of children with special needs find it much harder to meet with friends and socialise. We created a room which will enable us to bring together siblings, parents and grandparents in a safe space.
