The trustees present their report and accounts for the year ended 31 March 2021

Structure, governance and management

The charity was established under its constitution on 9 October 2017 and registered as a charity with the Charity Commission on the same date.

North Shields Polytechnic Club is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO), registered with the Charlty Commission and governed by its constitution, adopted 9 October 2017.

Trustees are appointed by either by agreement of the existing board of trustees, or by the members of the CIO in accordance with its constitution.

As part of the induction process, all trustees are provided with a copy of the CIO's constitution and the Charity Commission guidance CC3 – 'the essential trustee'. Copies of the CIO's latest annual report and financial statements will also be made available to all trustees.

The Charity and its property are managed and administered by a board of trustees, which can have between three and twelve members.

The trustees have assessed the major risks to which the charity is exposed, and are satisfied that systems are in place to mitigate exposure to the major risks

Objectives and activitie

The charity's objects are to promote community participation in healthy recreation for the public benefit by the provision of facilities for athletics in North Tyneside and the surrounding area, and by encouraging participation in athletics.

North Shields Polytechnic Club was established and registered on 9 October 2017, in order to transfer responsibility for the operation of North Shields Polytechnic AC from an unincorporated association governed by a committee, to a new CIO governed by a board of trustees.

In exercising their powers and duties, and in pursuing and carrying out the club's objects and activities, the Trustees have complied with the duty at s17(5) of the Charities Act 2011 to have due regard to the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit.

Achievements and performance

•The ongoing COVID-19 pandemic continued to have a significant impact on the activities of the Club. The measures put in place by the government to contain COVID-19 involved a high degree of social disruption which affected the delivery and demand for the activities of the Club.

•The Club was unable to hold the usual major events this year, namely the Clive Cookson 10k, the Xmas Pudding Run and the North Tyneside Trail or the Aquathlon, due to the government measures in place. As a result the Club missed out on a significant proportion of its regular income. The Club also saw a reduction in the associated costs of staging these events. The Club also saw a reduction in income ordinarily generated from the hire of the track facilities to third parties. Although the Clive Cookson 10k event did not take place, the Club was able to retain around helf the entry receipts for the event which will be rescheduled when possible.

•The Club made the decision to reduce subscription fees by 25% to assist members during the pandemic and the Club's membership continued to show strong support. This decision has resulted in a further reduction in income during the current year. The Club has made a similar decision to support members in the following year.

•The Club made two successful bids for grants from Sport England, to provide support during the COVID-19 crisis.

The relaxation of lockdown during 2021/22 is expected to result in a significant increase in income from organised events, sales of merchandising and fundraising.

Financial Review

The receipts and payments account on page 6 shows a surplus of receipts over payments of £7,876 for the year ended 31 March 2021.

Reserves policy

It is the policy of the charity that unrestricted funds which have not been designated for a specific use should be maintained at a minimum level of six months' operating expenditure. The trustees consider that reserves at this level will ensure that, in the event of a significant drop in funding, they will be able to continue the charity's corrent activities while consideration is given to ways in which additional funds may be raised. This level of reserves has been maintained throughout the Period.

Unrestricted Funds - General Reserves

The Club's general reserves are at the discretion of the Trustees and represent funds available for future use on capital projects or to fund the ongoing activities of the Club as needed. It is the club's policy to hold sufficient general reserves to meet 6 months' operating expenditure which is currently estimated at £15,000. General reserves at the year end were \pm 15,000 (2020: £15,000).

Unrestricted Funds - Designated Reserve

The designated (or forward funding) reserve is a reserve set aside to meet any major or capital expenditure of the Club which may be incurred in future periods. Such expenditure is of a non-recurrent nature and is not intended to be used to cover the ongoing activities of the Club. Example expenditure includes contributions towards club house refurbishment and track floodlights. Designated reserves at the year end were £85,226 (2020: £77,773).

Restricted Funds

Restricted funds are funds received which are to be used for a specific purpose, usually a condition of the donor. Restricted reserves at the year end were £593 (2020: £170).
