At the 2019 Festival (the 2020 and 2021 Festivals were cancelled due to COVID-19) INK produced 44 new short plays for stage and radio. This included a new musical, a young people's Play-in-A- Day, the winners of INK's new East Anglian community drama group. As a result of our Pen to Performance Schools Project, a 14 year old had her play produced at the Festival. For the first time the Festival included Stand- Up Comedy on the Saturday night slot. The INK Festival goes from strength to strength with a bumper crop of emerging talent. London is not the only creative hub in the country.
