In accordance with statutory requirement the sports centre and the associated football pitches were closed for norr use between March 2020 and Augus 2020, between November 2020 and December 2020, and between Janua 2021 and April 2021. Under the terms of the management Contract with Stevenage Leisure Limited (SLL) it continued to bear responsibility for the staff and for all health and safety measures needed 	t the ents i mal t ry

Once the facilities were permitted to open for use it was necessary to observe social distancing, to instigat extra cleaning and health safety measures, and to limit the number of people using the facilities. Achievements against objectives set	Para 1.41	Regrettably the Trustees were unable to make much progress with the site developers and the local authority regarding the handing over of additional facilities, primarily the adjoining cricket pitch. Negotiations for this are continuing. It had been hoped that this matter would have been settled by now. A further problem which affects the facilities is the rising level of vandalism and anti-social behaviour within the village. This is being addressed but remains a depressingly sad matter which works to the detriment of the Trust's aims.

Review of the charity's financial position at the end of the period	Para 1.21	The management Contract with SLL requires SLL to be responsible for all staff costs and for meeting the costs of maintaining the facilities. This is so whether or not the facilities are open or not. There is no liability on the Trust. However, the fact that the income from users was severely reduced meant that there was no surplus in the year to be shared with the Trust. The reduced income also meant that the obligation on SLL to adjust the profit and loss account to pay a notional rent was not met. As a consequence Trust has derived no income during this period. This is not immediately detrimental to the Trust but will put back the opportunity for development.
