OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The objectives of the charity are to advance education in Pakistan by the establishment, support and maintenance of a school and accommodation for the orphan and turned away children. We are committed to offering education to the turned away children living in Pakistan almost every corner of the country.

ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

During the reporting year, we aimed at to establish an independent institution under the umbrella of 'Teach me Please'. We tried to purchase land for school's building but due to high land prices in Islamabad our current resources do not permit us to buy a piece of land and erect a school building on it. Now we decided to support an educational institution which is providing education to the orphan and needy students on pro bono basis. We are already in talks with different institutions and collecting information from them and soon we would be able to reach to a decision that which institution needs our support. Very recently we had conducted a survey on Pakistani educational system, why this educational system is not so helpful to eliminate poverty from the life of common people?, for this purpose we conducted interviews with many educationists and their responses were the same. They replied that the said educational system is very generic and not focus on skill and personal development. Now we are aimed to support the educational institution which is more focus on skill and personal development.

We are also trying to spread our message to humanity at large to gather their support and to raise funds for this charity. We are also putting our efforts to display charity boxes at different places and trying to bring more professional people in support of this charity.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The charity had an opening balance of general funds amounting to £22,515 at the start of reporting year and received general donations of £21,692 during the year. At 31 March 2021 the charity had net assets of 44,207. The Trustees have reasonable expectation that the Trust have adequate resources to continue operating for the next twelve months.

PUBLIC BENEFIT

In shaping our objectives for the year and planning our activities, the Trustees have considered the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit, including the guidance on public benefit and fee charging. The Charity relies on the donation income it receives from its donors to cover its operating costs. There is no operating cost during the year.

TEACH ME PLEASE is focusing to provide modern education to the orphan, poor and turned away children in Pakistan and enable them to manage their own lives. Through this project, we would be able to save the children from child labour, which is equivalent to modern day slavery.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005) and applicable UK Generally Accepted Accounting Practice.

Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included on the Statement of Financial Activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

Resources expended

Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from income taxes on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
