Summary of main activities undertaken for the public benefit in relation to

these objectives:

The regular public celebration of the Divine Liturgy on Sunday together with

other occasional services as required and when possible; teaching of the

Faith and its practical implications (consistent with the objectives of the

charity) to enquirers, catechumens, children and members of the Antiochian

Orthodox Church.

The Board of Trustees are legally responsible for all civil aspects of the parish.

In order to fulfil these responsibilities, the Board has met at intervals, for the

most part online during the year, to discuss, among other day to day issues:

Covid 19

This has been a difficult year which has severely impacted our normal

activities owing to lockdowns and government restrictions on public

assembly. During the lockdown our services were suspended and when

restrictions were first relaxed, we were required to limit the number of people

attending. This resulted in a reduction in income from weekly contributions.

However, Trustees were able to counteract this loss by taking advantage of

the government furlough scheme for our one employee and negotiating a

reduction in rent for the period when we were not using the church.

Towards the end of the period covered by this report things were beginning to return to normality and Trustees look forward to a full and settled resumption of our activities.

Safeguarding

Trustees continue to monitor safeguarding and ensure that all volunteers are DBS checked as appropriate.
