Phase 3 has commencing, involving ancillary sheds, landscaping and tree-planting. This has involved a number of members and non-member volunteers, completing much of the work ourselves. Other volunteers have helped with painting and other tasks.  Winter seminar programme: online talks were provided to members  Beginners courses: A new weekend beginners course was launched this year in person within the new study centre. In addition, the weekly beginners course remained online for theory sessions. A total of 17 beginners participated in the courses.
