SUMMARY OF THE FRIENDS OF ST MARY'S ACTIVITIES DURING THE YEAR

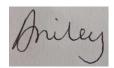
During the year under review The Friends of St Mary's raised **£45,067** which, after payment of fund raising and administration expenses, left a surplus of **£4,634** to be used to provide or assist in the provision of facilities or items for the education at the school. There was an overall deficit of **£44,458** for the year which has been added to brought forward reserves.

In addition, it was agreed by the management committe that from the 1 April 2018, the St. Mary's Fund (SMF); a fund setup to support the running of St. Mary's C of E Primary School Twickenham, will be managed by The Friends of St Mary's as a designated fund rather than acting as an agent. Of the accumulated funds carried forward, **£11,275**, is ring-fenced for
