For the public benefit, the prevention or relief of poverty in remote communities in Nepal and the provision of education for disadvantaged children in Nepal by providing grants, items and services to individuals in need and/or other charities or organisations working to achieve those objectives.

The Trustees are aware of the guidance on public benefit issued by the Charity Commission and have taken this into account in planning their activities for the year under review.

Activities have been significantly impacted as a result of the COVID pandemic however some fund raising has continued. The Trustees anticipate being able to re-engage properly with Tendi over the next 12-24 months so as to resume the charity's main activity for the public benefit, namely the ongoing granting of donations to TTSF Nepal to help fund the completion of the construction of a new community hall at Saisima in Nepal. Once completed, this building will support the education of disadvantaged children in the area. The principal building is now fully functional and work should start soon on a linked kitchen and dormitory facility.
