- To promote for the benefit of the public the conservation protection and improvement of the physical and natural environment of Wembdon Parklands; and
- To promote for the benefit of the inhabitants of Wembdon and the surrounding area the provision of facilities for recreation or other leisure time occupation of individuals who have need of such facilities by reason of their youth, age, infirmity or disablement, financial hardship or social and economic circumstances or for the

public at large in the interests of social welfare and with the object of improving the condition of life of the said inhabitants, by the maintenance, improvement and conservation of Wembdon Parklands.

The trustees have raised funds and with them carried out the work necessary to make improvements to Wembdon Parklands; by providing detailed working plans for the area and employed the services of experts to complete all the necessary groundwork, planting, and installation of leisure equipment.

We have planted a woodland area with approximately 30 mature trees; installed tarmac pathways that have made the area accessible to all users including the elderly and disabled and erected galvanised steel fencing and a gate to make it safer for vulnerable people.

We are enhancing and preserving a biodiverse habitat and nature trail leisure facility that is engaging childrens learning and is helping to improve parishioners' mental health. We have done this by preserving habitats and planted different areas to encourage more wildlife to return to the area and for people and wildlife to thrive. We have planted and continue to maintain and improve the prairie grass border and planted an orchard area which was once on the land years ago.

Summary of the main activities undertaken for the public benefit in relation to these objects (include within this section the statutory declaration that trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit)

Along the main path in front of the prairie orchard, we have installed seating and sensory boarders; that stimulate people with sensory disorders as well and increasing insects into the area. We have erected solar footpath lighting in strategic places making it easier for the public to walkthrough at night but dim enough not to effect bats in the area to the area. We have installed bird, and bat boxes.

We have created a Stumpery in a shady area of the park using local wood and it will keep evolving overtime with additional planting and timber. It is important for biodiversity as it is a haven for microorganisms, invertebrates, and reptiles.

The planting we have carried out is vitally important towards combating traffic emissions from the busy main road next to the parkland and help improve the quality of air for the public whilst at the same time helping to combat global warming.

In delivering our objectives, the trustees have worked closely with Wembdon Parish Council who own the public land and with our sponsors and we will continue to do so, to maintain and improve a key recreational facility for the wellbeing of the people of Wembdon and surrounding areas.

In carrying out our activities the trusties have met their objectives and have demonstrated their regard on the guidance for Public Benefit, issued by the Charities Commission Section 17(5) of the Charities Act and the Charities (Accounts and Reports) Regulations 2008.
