REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2021

The Trustees present their report with the receipts and payments account for the charity for the year ended 31 December 2021. The trustees have adopted the receipts and payments account method for presenting the accounts as the charity is not a company and its income has not exceeded £250,000.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The objectives of the Society are:

- the promotion of knowledge of the arts, sciences and culture of the United Kingdom and Denmark
- the award of grants for educational study in the United Kingdom and Denmark
- the support of any other charitable activities

In order to further these objects, the Scholarship Committee of the Society meets annually to consider grant applications received from graduates of both Danish and British Institutes of Higher Education.

The Scholarship Committee approves scholarship grants within the annual award budget set by Council.

The main area of activity is the organising of social and cultural events for the Society's members.

The Council has referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the Society's aims and objectives and in planning future activities. In particular the Council has considered how planned activities will contribute to the aims and objectives that it has set.

Powers

The Council has absolute discretion in all matters concerning the application of the above objective's.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

The Society awarded a total of 8 individual scholarship grants covering the academic year 2021/22 amounting to £17,500 from the Anglo-Danish Society Fund with a further grant of £2,500 from the Ove Arup Foundation. All grants have been taken up.

With Covid-19 restrictions in force for the first part of the year, the 2021events programme for physical gatherings were still not up to pre-pandemic levels. However, the second half of the year saw some five physical get-togethers in addition to Zoom events and meetings.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Financial position

The Society's receipts exceeded payments by £2,445, (2020: payments exceeded receipts £5,865).

Investment policy and objectives

The Society's assets which consist both of balance with banks and investments, are held with the purpose of generating funds which will enable it to meet the objectives of the charity.

Reserves policy

The Society held assets as reserves at the 31 December 2021 amounting to £193,756 (2020: £172,543) comprising; £69,826 balances with banks (2020: £67,381) and £123,930 investments (2020: £105,162). Besides being held to generate income to meet the objectives of the Society, the reserves are held to be utilised when, at any time, income generated is insufficient to meet the Society's commitments under its objectives.

COVID-19

This year saw an improving situation over 2020 in terms of social contact, the economy and the workplace. The gradual relaxing of rules meant cultural and social events were once more possible and interaction with our membership slowly restored once more.

As a Society we have been fortunate to have such a loyal membership base and have our Council staffed by volunteers who have remained committed throughout the pandemic.

Our low-cost operation plus subscription revenue stream is underpinned by a strong reserves position which should allow the Society to manage and sustain its grants policy with no significant threat to the Society as a going concern.

Whilst we continue to assess the impact of the Covid-19 virus, we remain optimistic for 2022 in that the gradual return to a new normality will continue in general, social and economic terms.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust, and constitutes an unincorporated charity.

The Society is a charity registered with the Charity Commission number 313202.

The rules approved in 1953 (as subsequently amended), form the governing document of the charity.

Appointment of Council Members

New Council members are recruited from present members of the Society. In the notification of a forthcoming Annual General Meeting the Council will each year invite all members of the Society to put forward names for election.

Names of nominees, who must be paid up members of the Society and must have agreed to let their names go forward, are sent to the Honorary Secretary to reach him/her no later than seven days before the Annual General Meeting. New elections are subsequently approved at the Annual General Meeting.

Organisational Structure

The Society's activities are supervised by the Council which meets quarterly.

Council Membership

The Council shall consist of no fewer than six, and no more than twenty members. Members are elected at the Annual General Meeting as vacancies arise. Casual vacancies may be filled by the Council and shall be subject to confirmation at the next Annual General Meeting. Tenure of membership of the Council is for three years after which a period of at least one year shall elapse before a member may seek re-election. This does not apply to the Society's serving officers nor the ex-officio members of Council representing The Danish Embassy, The Danish Church in London and Dansk KFUK in London.

Under changes to the Society's Rules agreed by members at the 10 June 2021 AGM, a new method of electing a Chairman, Vice-chairman and officers will come into effect from 1 January 2022. Under these changes these positions will no longer be elected or appointed annually by Council but elected by members at each AGM. It was also agreed at the AGM to add a fourth ex-officio seat on council: The Danish-UK Association.

Risk Management

The Council has assessed the major risks attributable to the Charity and is satisfied that adequate systems are in place to mitigate exposure to these major risks.
