Report of the Trustees

Period Ended 30 June 2021

The trustees present their annual report and the unaudited financial statements for the period ended 30th June 2021. The trustees have adopted the provisions of the statement of recommended practice (SORP) "accounting and reporting by charities" issued 2005 in preparing the annual report and financial statements of the charity.

Objectives of the charity, principal activities and organisation of our work

The aim of Inclusively Taekwondo is to bring people together, develop friendships, tackle isolation and build community cohesion through a shared passion for the sport of Taekwondo.

We help children and adults with additional needs to reach their goals and fulfil their potential in a safe, friendly environment bringing the physical and social benefits of taekwondo to everyone in the community.

Students with additional needs are given tailored, individual support enabling them to train, progress and compete as independently as possible within their individual capabilities.

The support offered by inclusively taekwondo is tailored to individual needs and includes:

One to one sessions

Students who do not have the confidence to participate in any taekwondo classes are given one to one tuition with an Inclusively Taekwondo instructor.

Specialist sessions

Classes are run on a Saturday specifically for students with additional needs.

Support sessions

Designated Academy classes are available where an Inclusively Taekwondo instructor is present to support students with additional needs.

1. Accounting Policies

1.1 Basis of preparation of accounts

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention. The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the statement of recommended practice, accounting and reporting by Charities (SORP 2005) issued in March 2005.

1.2 Incoming resources

Voluntary income and donations are included in incoming resources when they are received, except when the donors specify that they must be used for future accounting periods or donors conditions have been fulfilled, then the income is deferred. The income from fundraising ventures is shown gross, with the associated costs in fundraising costs.

1.3 Resources expended

Resources expended are included in the statement of financial activities on an accrual basis, inclusive of VAT which cannot be recovered.

Expenditure which is directly attributable to specific activities has been included in these cost categories. Where costs are attributable to more than one activity, they have been apportioned across the cost categories on a basis consistent with the use of these resources.

1.4 Tangible fixed assets

Individual fixed assets costing £1,000 or more are capitalised at cost after deducting any specific grants received. Depreciation is provided on all tangible fixed assets at rates calculated to write off the cost over their expected useful economic lives.

1.5 Governance Costs

Governance costs include those incurred in the governance of the charity and its assets and are primarily associated with constitutional and statutory requirements.
