Arcobaleno Cancer Trust Easter Raffle

Due to the pandemic, this year's flagship event Race Night was cancelled so an online raffle was carried out raising £6444

Arcobaleno Cancer Trust Grants -

In June 2021 ACT donated £29,500 to the Royal Marsden payable in two instalments. Half in 2021 and the other half in 2022. The money is for three projects. £10500 goes towards a Scalp Cooler Machine, a machine that helps to reduce hair loss during chemotherapy. £9000 is going towards a Medical Precision Tattoo Set, a new-to-market medical precision tattoo set which uses non-permanent tattoos to create 'tattoo dots' to ensure that the radiotherapy is targeted in the right place. £10,000 is going towards a Halo plus 3 software for Al parthology which is an imaging analysis package, that is used to identify cells and to count differenct types of cells within a patient's tumour.

In April 2021 ACT awarded £5,000 to Spencer McCall, a young footballer who was diagnosed with Ewing's Sarcoma, a rare bone cancer. The money was granted to him to support him with alternative treatment costs due to the cancer having spread also to the lungs and chemotherapy no longer working. Sadly he passed away in July 2021.

Arcobaleno Cancer Trust Woodland Walk 2021

Completed our third woodland remembrance walk in Highgate woods raising awareness for Arcobaleno Cancer Trust and the work we are doing. We raised £880.00

Siobhan's Superstar Legacy

In 2019 ACT awarded the Bradley Lowery Foundation to help further the chances of full recovery of two year old Siobhan Mather to travel to get a vaccine which was only available in America. Sadly in July 2019 Siobhan passed away. The relationship between ACT and the Mather family continued to grow and in 2021 Siobhan's Superstar Legacy was formed with ACT, with the aim of putting the money that was raised for Siobhan's treatment to good use, supporting other families dealing with childhood cancer and to support further cancer research particularly those cancers affecting children. In October 2021, the Bradley Lowery Foundation who the family previously raised the money with transferred £203,957.82 to ACT for this purpose
