Contribution made by volunteers	Para 1.38	Volunteers support is vital to the trust, both directly engaged in the development and management of the site and in raising funds. Volunteers have been involved in tree planting and local fund raising including assisting with car washes and the village dog show and fayre. Volunteers have provided feedback on play equipment and supported the initial set up of the site infrastructure.

Despite continued disruption due to COVID, the trust has been successful in engaging with WNC and Northamptonshire Highways to fund and develop the external path needed to access the site. This engagement has been successful and saw the external path built by WNC in Q1 22. The trust has been able to secure the majority of the funds required to develop children's play equipment onto the site and, having selected a preferred supplier have placed and order and are expecting construction to start late Aug / early Sep 22. The Trust has also successfully cleared all of the remaining conditions placed against its planning approval.
