### **Background**

Established in 2016, Newcastle Athletics Development Association (NADA) is a charity which aims to improve the standard and accessibility of athletics facilities in Newcastle upon Tyne. NADA operates, and is managed by a group of committed volunteers. This report provides an overview of activities delivered in the name of NADA for the purpose of their charitable objectives in the calendar year 2021.

### **Main Activities**

The focus and attention of NADA has centred on the redevelopment of the City Stadium site in the Ouseburn area of Newcastle. This follows the community consultation exercise completed in 2017 that gave clear indication that a purpose built, open-access, outdoor athletics facilities would be greatly appreciated by a wide demographic of stakeholders.

As the development of the City Stadium site is largely in the control of two major stakeholders, Newcastle City Council and Urban Green Newcastle, our charity has had a limited capacity for the majority of the year. We continue to liaise with Newcastle City Council on potential use of the City Stadium, although the aftermath of the Covid-19 pandemic has essentially halted our activities in 2021.

***Financial statement***

NADA raise funds from the public and use these to contribute to charitable activities solely for the purpose achieving their charitable objectives.

The 2021 financial year (1<sup>st</sup> January to 31st December, as per NADAs constitution) was quiet for NADA (as noted above) – this financial statement reflects that.
