Further difficulties following Covid were experienced during year within our charity shop due to lower foot fall and the cost of living problems filtering through later in year. Going forward we will reinstate our contract with the local CAB who will give help to clients with any problems they may have with regards to benefits claims and housing etc. Independent living help was given through our two owned properties with rents kept at the lowest rate possible to help tenants.
