Objectives and activities

Summary of the objects of the charity set out in its governing document

To advance the education of young people up to the age of twenty-one, from severely disadvantaged backgrounds and living in developing countries, by working with charitable organisations and/or local NGOs selected at the discretion of the trustees, to provide advice and assistance, organise programs of educational and other activities, and providing scholarships for study, as a means of: a) advancing in life and helping young people by developing their skills, capacities and capabilities to enable them to participate in society as independent, mature and responsible individuals; (b) advancing education; (c) relieving

unemployment; (d) providing activities in the interests of social welfare for people living in the area of benefit who have need by reason of their youth, age, infirmity or disability, poverty or social and economic circumstances with a view to improving the conditions of life of such persons.

The charity received the bulk of its endowment on 24th November 2021 and at the end of the accounting period had not yet invested it in income yielding stocks.

At its inaugural meeting the assessment of the need for a charity to invest in sustained education for the children of very poor families in developing countries was approved. The aim of the trust is to provide educational opportunities which can be sustained over several years.

Those present resolved that the foundation will endeavour to build funds and invest these funds to provide income from capital to fund scholarships and other educational activities. At the end of the financial period therefore no income had been generated by the endowment to carry out this activity.
