Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year	Partnerships with parents are strong creating strength within the preschool. Parents speak highly of the care their children receive and say that they make good progress in their leaning and development. They describe the staff as fantastic, supportive and caring.

St Johns Pre-School playgroup is currently dependent on LEA funding to sustain its activities, as earned income from fees alone would not allow St Johns Pre-school Playgroup to continue operating. To avoid closure if funding difficulties were to happen the Committee board had agreed to keep to a certain level of financial reserves to ensure that main operations can continue for a period of 6 months. This includes redundancy pay and staff wages at an amount of £38000. Reserves are also kept to comply with staff training as part of statutory guidance as part of the EYFS framework. Finally, reserves are also held
