

Administration Details

This report covers the period from 1st April 2021 to 31st March 2022 (the end of its financial year).

The Charity was established on the 14th April 2020 with charity number 1189051 and its registered address is Romshed Courtyard, Underriver, Nr Sevenoaks, and Kent TN15 0SD. It is not known by any other name.

Structure, Governance and Management

The Charity is governed by its constitution and is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation the only voting members of which are its charity trustees. The Trustees are all appointed for an initial term of three years by a resolution passed at a properly convened meeting of the charity trustees.

The Charity is managed and run by the Trustees and there are no paid or voluntary staff members.

Objectives and Activities

To fund and support purposes which are wholly and exclusively charitable according to the laws of England and Wales.

Section D:

Achievements and Performance

Funding of the Charity during this period was provided by the filming of the First Series of "The Larkins" at Romshed Farm (referred to in the Trustees' Annual Report 2020-21) in the sum of £145,500 and donations were made to 14 registered charities totalling £82,650.

Section E:

Financial Review

As at 31^{st} March 2022, the Charity had reserves of £109,647 (2021 - £13,716) less provisions and a liability of NIL (2021 - £6,100) £39,280 being a provision to pay donations to two charities, which was settled post year end.

In the period under review, the Trustees agreed with the production company, OF Productions, for the filming of a 2^{nd} series of "The Larkins" at Romshed Farm, which filming took place in the early parts of the next financial year. During the next financial year, companies controlled by the Trustees donated in excess of £700,000 to the Trust following the sale of the freehold reversion of Dundee Court, a warehouse building controlled by those companies in Docklands.
