During the financial year 2021-22, Coastlands activities were restricted. This was because, although the Trustees of Coastlands Family Church agreed the charity, a charity formed by Deed of Trust, should become a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) in 2020, the new Charity was not registered with the Charity Commission until January 2021.

In registering the the new Charity, the Commission gave its permission for the transfer of the assets of Coastlands Family Church to Coastlands.. However, for 2021-22, there was limited activity undertaken by Coastlands, pending the transfer of assets and activities.
