Circuit Trustee report 2021/22

Review of Circuit activities

This has been a year of recovery for the circuit as we have tried to reassess our activities and what we should be doing after the disruptions caused by covid.

The Circuit Meeting has taken back responsibility for decision making now that we are able to meet in person. The decision was taken to close one chapel, at Coveney. There were discussions as to whether we could make use of the building in another way, but this was not possible. The decision was therefore taken to begin the process of selling the property.

The meeting also agreed to extend the appointment of Rev Colin Watkins for one year on a part-time basis and to appoint Rev Catherine Dixon as Superintendent from September 2023 until 2029.

The circuit continues to resource the churches through the provision of preachers for their weekly services. We have begun the support and training of one new preacher during this year. We have also continued weekly Zoom based services for those unable to attend, these have now moved to monthly.

The circuit has continued to assist and oversee governance matters such as Safeguarding and GDPR, providing training and guidance across the circuit for those who require it.

Our circuit overseas project, *Bees Beds and Blessings*, has continued. This project aims to support the work of a women's hostel in Jamaica through the provision of beehives for the production and sale of honey to make the work there sustainable in the long term.

The circuit also encouraged fund raising for a number of other charities: *All We Can, Methodist Homes* and *Action For Children* among others, and has continued its grant of £2,000 per year for the Ely branch of *Christians against Poverty*. The circuit also pledged to help CAP in practical ways.

A grant was given to the Pulse Mission among the senior schools in the area and we continue to part fund the Lay Worker at Red Lodge in their work among the children of the town.

The circuit has provided the churches of the circuit with various grants for repairs and improvements to buildings. This year the total grants paid out to our churches for this purpose was in the region of £4650.
