The UMT member appointed will serve until the date of the next AGM, after which the post will be filled by election.</i>

To promote the development of young people in achieving their physical, intellectual and social potential as individuals and as responsible citizens by the provision of education and leisure time activities using a nautical theme and in accordance with the principles, ethos and practices of the Marine Society & Sea Cadets (MSSC)		
<b>The Unit's main activities and achievements in the financial year were:-</b>		
The Unit has been undergoing a refurbishment. During this time we moved to a temporary classroom. Due to covid restrictions slowly being lifted we were able to get some cadets ashore on day trips.

The aim is to promote the development of young people in achieving their physical, intellectual and social potential as individuals and responsible citizens in a safe environment. In order to achieve this the Unit takes young people from all backgrounds, including where possible those with disabilities and develops their skills and abilities by:
