We have had to make significant refunds for reduced 20-21 subs to reflect the limited playing time but this was off-set by lower operating costs during that season.

Financial Review

Review of the charity's financial position at the end of the period	Para 1.21	The funds at the end of the period stood at £9,765 against a starting balance of £14,184. Considering that this included £6,149 in refunds from the previous season this can be considered an excellent result. Overall, the cash in bank represents a significant improvement on previous years and leaves us with a sufficient balance to consider additional kits and equipment.

The main risk to income in the next period is a drop in subs payments through a reduction in teams/players but this is unlikely. We are satisfied that we do not require reserves to be held
