Report of the Trustees for the Year ended 30th June 2022

The Trustees present their Annual Report and Financial statement for the year ended 30th June 2022. The Financial Statement has been prepared in accordance with the Constitution of Severn Dean Lions Club (CIO) dated 19 April 2018 and the requirements of the Charities Act 2011.

Structure, Governance & Management

Severn Dean Lions Club (CIO) has been a registered Charity since April 2018.

The Club is a member of Lions Clubs International

The Club is managed in accordance with its Constitution and Grant Making Policy.

The Club has five Trustee positions that are elected as Officers on an annual basis.

The Club holds a monthly business meeting of all members and Trustees

The monthly meeting considers received requests for Welfare/Support funding Grants, Volunteering activities, Lions Clubs National and International matters, planned fund raising activities and Social activities.

Summary of all 2021/2022 Activities.

The relaxing of the "Covid" pandemic regulations has enabled the Club to re-engage fully with its three core fund raising activities:

The Annual "Wild Boar Chase" Mountain Bike Event held each September

The Annual Bonfire and Fireworks display event held each November

The Annual "MacMillan" Coffee morning event held each September/October

Small sums are realised each year via the use of online donation sites such as "Amazon Smile" and "Easyfundraising"

The success of these events has allowed the Club Funds available to be replenished after the period of the previously mentioned Pandemic.

The Club has recruited three new members during this year.
