The Charity was established in 1788 by a group of local residents in the Parish of Dittisham and in 1879 a trust deed was drawn up and registered with the Charities Commission (No. 258288). This was further amended in 1966 and 2014.

The Charity was established primarily for the repair and maintenance of the properties of the Parish Church of Dittisham. With no remaining separate properties, the current objective of the Trust is for payment of any charges lawfully incurred by the Churchwardens in the maintenance and repair of the fabric of the Church and, subject thereto, in payment of the like charges in respect of services of the said Church and the furniture thereof.

The attached accounts show the current state of the finances, which the Trustees consider to be sound.

The income of the Trust for 2022 was £25,326 (2021 - £22,850) and expenditure was £nil (2021 - £10,000).

The market value of the investments held in the Permanent Endowment Funds, Accumulated Income Funds & bank accounts at 31 December 2022 amounted to £673,403 (2021 - £716,140).
