Structure, Governance and Management

Governing document : Constitution adopted on 24 November 2017

The Charity is a trust registered as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation

Trustees are appointed as volunteers and based on their connection with the founding rationale for the charity, their experience and skills needed to pursue the objectives of the Trust, to drive strategy and also ensure effective management and governance.

Objectives and Activities

The objects of the Charity are :

a) The preservation and protection of mental health among young people residing permanently or temporarily in the South of England by the provision of help and support to such young people who have experienced or who are currently experiencing mental health problems.

b) The advancement of education of mental health issues among young people to promote understanding in the wider community.

The trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on providing a public benefit and consider that the activities undertaken fulfil the charitable purposes of the Trust.

Achievements and performance

The financial results and statement of assets and Babilities are shown on page 2. In summary the Charity reported a surglus of £19.899 during the year.

As reported last year, the Charity post Covid lock downs would seek to reintroduce its fund raising events in 2021-22. We are therefore pleased to report that this year our gross income rose to £142,800 up from £84,417 in the prior year. The Charity received a £4,000 grant from Elmbridge Borough Council to support counseilling at schools. However, we were also delighted to be chosen by the current Mayor of Elmbridge to be his Charity of the Year. This had a significant effect on this year under review as not only did the total sum raised exceed £30,000, the publicity that the events held provided us with a significant increase in profile throughout the borough and beyond beiping advance the awaronoss of mental health.

The trust has continued to be supported by several companies with their staff holding fund raisers on our behalf or for us to be nominated for an award during the year reflecting the support we get from our community. We see an increasing number of businesses recognising the importance of mental health and this is reflected in the support we receive.

The main focus for the Charity in 2021-22 was to continue to boild our relations with local schools, understand their needs and work with them to support mental health. We have continued to support 9 schools in 2021-22. Support comes in different forms from funding of counselling services, mental health training and conferences Including self harm and eating disorders. We continue to provide funds for Mental Health First Aid to schools and local Sports Clubs,

in total, in 2021-222 we provided support totalling £101,255 to schools and local groups and the trustees are pleased to report that this record level of support has been provided with volunteer support only with minimal overhead. Our main costs are website deigen and maintenance, insurance and promotional materials. We have no employees and the bulk of all money raised is therefore directly available to support our objects as referred to above.

Having achieved our goal of re-establishing our fund raising activities in 2021-22 we are now in a strong position going into 2022-23 to look for further opportunities to support mental health In our communities. We will expand further the geographic spread of the schools we support, will continue to support the Grace Dear Theatre project as well as introduce additional Arts projects to aid mental well being among young people both inside and outside of the school gates.

Financial Review

The Charity only commits funds that are already generated to ensure that it remains solvent at all times.

Funds raised for specific purposes are distributed in accordance with any conditions of that fund raising, for example grants.
