To encourage active participation of parents/guardians to achieve these objectives

To administer the leases and assets of the club.

To ensure that the club is run within the legal constraints and articles of the Child Protection Act.

To ensure the club is run in a professional manner by the committee and to promote and encourage junior football for both boys and girls between the ages of 5 and 18.

Provides facilities and opportunities for children to take part in playing football and associated training and development of individual and team skills.

In addition, the club provides training and education for adults in line with the Football Association Governing Body guidelines for teaching children. Charities Legislation requires the Trustees to prepare accounts for each financial year which gives a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the club, and of the surplus or deficit of the club for the said period. In preparing those accounts, the Trustees are required to:- Select suitable accounting policies and then apply them consistently. Make judgements and estimates that are reasonable. The Trustees are responsible for ensuring that arrangements are made for keeping proper accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the club.

They are also responsible for safeguarding the assets of the club and hence for taking reasonable steps for the prevention and detection of fraud and other irregularities.
