The Trust is registered with the Charity Commission and constituted by a deed of trust.

The principal address of the charity is St. Paul's Vicarage, 58 Abbotsbury Road, Weymouth. Dorset, DT4 0BJ.

The Charity is administered by the trustees. Until July 2022, the trustees were Father Attila Gregory Lipovsky., Mrs Sharon Waight, Mr. David Harrison, and Mr Christopher James.

Mr Harrison resigned in July and was replaced by Mrs Gillian Cox. Mrs Waight resigned in November.

The object of the charity is to maintain the parish hall for the benefit of the parishioners and surrounding community. The hall is let to various groups at an affordable cost. The Trust also owns the former curates' house, (49e Abbotsbury Road) which is let to long-term tenants.

All proceeds after maintenance of the hall and house are to be used for the benefit of the church of St. Paul, Weymouth.

During the year the Trustees transferred the amount of £10,016 to the Parochial Church Council.

Grants were received amounting to £8,846.

# 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

#### Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

#### Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

#### Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

#### **Fund accounting**

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.
