INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF THE NORTHAMPTON TRANSPORT HERITAGE – 1194533

I report on the accounts of the Northampton Transport Heritage for the year ended 31st December 2022 which are set out on pages 2 to 3.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner
