We have continued to involve all our members and provided a positive, social, responsive environment that is secure, safe and welcoming. Encouraging friendship and supporting individuals. This has enabled us to continue to provide much-needed support in the community and for the players to be able to enjoy and play the sport in a safe and controlled environment.

West Leeds ARLFC welcomes all people regardless of personal background, circumstances, faith, gender, age, sexuality and believes there is a role for everyone young and old within our organisation.

Without the help and support of the non-playing members' weekend, games and activities within the organisation would not happen.

In 2022 we continue to gain support from the local community and secure the remaining funding needed for the project.

The plan is to start the building in early 2023 and to continue to recruit players and volunteers from the community.

Our volunteers have remained supportive during the difficult period and pulled together in helping move equipment, maintain the changing rooms, keep the area of the pitch tidy from rubbish and promote our aims and project.
