This demonstrates slow, but steady, growth. The support group is vital in connecting individuals with hemiplegia who have no other means of peer advice and support. Members have said that they continue to find the group valuable but that they would welcome, if possible, an in-person presence. The trustees continued to make plans for an in-person event. The trustees appointed Ellie Martin to join them to support the strategic development of the charity. Ellie brings a strong strategic
