The accounting period for the group was amended in the period and is now to run to 31st August. This was amended to tie in with the operating year of the Scout Group and completion of each of the 3 terms (Autumn/Winter, Spring and Summer). As a result this period of Accounts now reflects a 16 month period

The new Group Treasurer was appointed in January 2023

The Group continues to operate 2 x Beaver Colonies, 2 x Cub Packs and 2 x Scout Troups along with an Explorer Unit and generally has good numbers and attendance

Along with activities throughout the year for all sections Group Camps were arranged for July 2022 (Hesley Wood) and 2023 (Bradley Wood) with good attendance and have been deemed a great success

The Group has been banking with HSBC for a number of years and in March 2023 opened an online bank account with CAF Bank to facilitate easier access, reinsbusement of expenses and to integrate with OSM which is now operated by all Sections

The Group continue to have good numbers of Leader although additional support is always welcomed and many sections have made appeals for parent helpers and assistants. The Group also continues to promote scouting within the community and has a waiting list for entry into the Beaver session, that is curretly able to offer a place for all young persons at the entry age.

The group is hugely appreciative of the amount of time and effort given by everyone involved in what has been another difficult year to balance finances following recovery from the COVID pandemic

We would extend our thanks to everyone involved for continuing to make 3rd Harrogate Scouts a safe, happy and successful group.
