The Objects of the CIO are:

- to advance in life and help children and young people through the provision of social, cultural, physical and educational activities in the interest of social welfare for people who have need by reason of their youth, financial hardship or other disadvantage; and
- to make grants to organisations and individuals for the charitable purpose of advancing the education of young people and reliving those by reason of their youth, financial hardship or other in need disadvantage.

For the year to 31 December 2022, for the public benefit, the charity continued to run youth workshops and educational programs focused on art, music, creativity and creative learning. A new topic that was introduced is coding, with great success.

These workshops are designed to foster healthy social interaction and self-expression.

In addition, we have trained adults to build capacity among adults to become facilitators working with children and young people for our youth programs and other organisations.

In performing these Activities in furtherance of the charity's objects the trustees have had due regard to the charity commission's guidance on public benefit.

Funtasia Impact provide youth and adults around the world with the tools they need to excel as healthy, fulfilled and contributed citizens. Our goal is to spread localization of our programs to underserved communities and reduce educational inequalities

Funtasia Impact utilises a multidisciplinary educational approach curated through global collective sources.

We make relevant, vibrant content available, which promotes self-directed learning, empathy, sharpens analytical and innovative thinking, communication skills, and supports academic education by improving school attendance and engagement.

During 2022 the following activities were implemented:

- 1 Youth workshop "Mural Workshop" for children/youth sponsored by A&K Foundation at Funtasia Luxor Center (participants number 24)
- 2 Youth workshops "Education is life" for children/youth sponsored by Sawiris Foundation (participants number 466)
- 1 Educational program sponsored by Sawiris Foundation "Me & myhealth" about learning how to take care of physical and mental health (participants 103)
- 6 Adult Training in Assuit sponsored by Sawiris Foundation "Education is Life" (participants number 152)
- 1 Adult Training in Cairo sponsored by Stable Antar NGP (20 participants)
- 3 Adult Trainings at Funtasia Luxor Center sponsored by Planererra (27 participants)

The Luxor centre continues to provide quality education for underserved communities.

Through all these these programs in 2022 Funtasia Impact has reached a total

of 593 and young people and trained 199 adults in Egypt.
