The Trustees present their annual report and financial statements for the year ended 31 March 2023. The Trustees confirm that the annual report and financial statement comply with the current statutory requirements, the requirements of the charity's governing document and the provisions of the Statement of Recommended Practice (SORP), applicable to the charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015) as amended by Update Bulletin 1 (effective 1 January 2015).

Structure, Governance, and Management

Governing Document

The constitution was adopted on 18th May 2018 and later updated in December 2022.

Appointment of Trustees

Trustees are appointed annually. A minimum of two trustees is required as a quorum to make any decisions on behalf of the charity.

OBJECTIVE AND ACTIVITIES

The organization commenced In September 2016 and became a Registered Charity on 30th May 2018.

The objective of the charity is to provide memory and mind stimulating various creative activities, entertainment as well as moderate physical activities for people of any age living in London who have mild to moderate memory issues or depression or suffering from loneliness due to memory problems, terminal conditions etc. Our services also include outreach, help, advice, information, and signposting to other health professionals.

MAIN ACTIVITIES- PUBLIC BENEFITS

London

This year our services were overwhelmingly successful.

We continued to grow our services to different parts of London. For example, we started our services at Newham General Hospital at Dementia Unit working with one to one patients, making paintings, various craft as well as reminiscing with them. It became so successful among patients and staff. As a result, we were asked to extend these services in the future.

Our recycling project "Carbon Smart City" was finished successfully at two sites Aldgate & Barbican.

And finally, our City Memory group at Barbican is running extremely well as usual. We received and receiving continuously positive feedback from our users, families, volunteers and guest volunteers. We are oversubscribed now! It is hard to believe that we started this group in 2016 with only 7 users and no volunteers! Now we have 39 users, 12 regular volunteers and are still growing. We continued our relationship with ELBA (East London Business Alliance), Big Alliance, Standard Chartered Bank and Acuity International (to name but a few) and providing opportunity for them to be guest volunteers at our different projects.

Our CEO is Madhumita Bose, who was responsible for managing all London Services for last 8 years.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The Statement of financial activities shows a net surplus of £ 11,542 for the year. The management committee has put necessary controls in place to avoid any mismanagement of funds.

RESERVE POLICY

On 31 March 2023 the charity has unrestricted reserve of £ 26,190 in addition to restricted funds of 326 to cover specific projects and core funds become payable in the financial year commencing 1 April 2023. The funds are held to cover at least three months operational cost in the event of loss of income and to meet any unforeseen expenditure that may occur.

1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1.1 Basis of preparation of financial statements

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Accounting and Reporting by Charities:Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to chaities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015) - (Charities SORP (FRS 102)), the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102).

Forget Me NOT Memory Cafe meets the defination of a public benefit entity under FRS 102. Assets and liabilities are initially recognised at historical cost or transaction value unless otherwise stated in the relevant accounting policy.

The Charity prepares its financial statements in sterling, the functional currency of the Charity, and amounts are rounded to the nearest £.

1.3 Income

All income is recognised once the Charity has entitlement to the income, it is probable that the income will be received and amount of income receivable can be measures reliably.

1.4 Expenditure

Expenditure is recognised once there is a legal or constructive obligation to transfer economic benefit to a third party, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably.

Support costs are those costs incurred directly in support of expenditure on the objects of the Charity and include costs of overall management of the Charity. Governance costs are those incurred in connection with administration of the Charity and compliance with constitutional and statutory requirements.

Costs of generating funds are costs incurred in attacting voluntary income, and those incurred in trading activities that raise funds.

Charitable activities and Governance costs incurred on the Charity's educational operations, including support costs and cost relating to the governace of the Charity's apportioned to the charitable activities.

1.5 Cash at bank and in hand

Cash at bank and in hand includes cash only.
