During this reporting period the Bradley Park Community Centre has remained closed as a result of Covid and other challenges. The extensive outdoor recreational areas have remained open and fully accessible for local people and groups to use. Maintenance of the external areas has continued. Throughout the reporting period a local gardener has rented a storage container on Bradley Park to support his business and a local individual leased the 'depot' (former storage space) for delivering personal fitness sessions and training to local people.
