## Objects and activities

To work in partnership with a range of community organisations and agencies to relieve poverty or financial hardship among residents and their dependants living in the S20 area of Sheffield, by providing bespoke emergency food parcels and other such items and supplies as may be necessary from time to time, as well as health/housing/money advice, education and any other necessary support designed to enable individuals to generate a sustainable income and become self-sufficient.

To prevent or relieve poverty through undertaking and supporting research into factors that contribute to poverty and the most appropriate ways to mitigate these.

### Achievements and Performance

This was the seventh year of the S20 Food Bank and by far the busiest that we have ever experienced. The financial year started relatively steadily and in line with the previous year but as the winter came and the cost of living crisis began to kick in, in turn we began to see a stark increase in the need for our services.

A dive into our statistics shows some interesting and somewhat worrying trends. From April 2022 – March 2023, the Food Bank saw 195 unique clients, which represents a 28% increase on the previous year. The total number of people fed in the households supported was 375 (a 22.1% increase on the previous year) and also included 113 children (a 29.9% increase on last year).

In line with this, the number of food parcels distributed was up from 941 in 2021/22 to 1378 in 2022/23 (a 46.4% increase). Also, the total amount of food distributed was 25,562.1kg 19,163.6kg (a 33.4% increase compared to last year).

These statistics represent our busiest year on record. Even busier than at the height of the 2020 COVID Lockdowns.

Whilst we do not know the full story behind each client's circumstances, it is clear that the 'cost of living' crisis is having a major impact on people's lives. Many of the referral forms that we have received reference the fact that people were struggling to pay their bills due to increases in household gas and electric prices.

This is further evidenced by the fact that we also spent £650.00 on providing winter fuel support to families in our area. By comparison, we only spent £60.00 providing this support in 2021/22.

We are also supporting people for longer periods of time than in the previous year, which suggests that people's regular incomes are not sufficient for their outgoings and they are finding it harder to exit the crisis that has brought them to needing our support.

We are incredibly indebted to our amazing team of volunteers, without whom we would not be able to carry out our service for the people in our community. Throughout the last year, we have had in the region of 30 people volunteer with us at different times. Each fulfilling a different but vital role in the operation.

It was great to be able to take these volunteers out for a Thank You meal to acknowledge all of their hard work in incredibly difficult circumstances.

We were however, terribly sad to mourn the loss of one of volunteers, Brian Wilks in December 2022. Brian was a valued member of our team who was loved and appreciated by all of our volunteers and also the clients to whom he used to deliver food parcels. RIP Brian.

The Charity is also very fortunate to have a very committed and capable Trustee Board, which works tireless behind the scenes to ensure that the Charity has everything that it needs to fulfil its aims and objectives and remains compliant with all of the relevant legislation and guidance.

We also want to acknowledge the many hours put in by our Treasurer Rosalind Wastnidge to ensure that our finances are properly managed and accounted for.

In the last 12 months, we have received donations of 13,897.54kg worth of food (a very welcome 26.95% increase on last year) which represented a financial value of £24,320.70. Much of this came from local individuals and businesses getting in touch to offer donations without us even having to put an appeal out. This demonstrated a huge amount of goodwill from the general public to us for the work that we were doing.

We were also very grateful beneficiaries of food donations from our local ASDA and Morrisons as well as donations from Waitrose which are facilitated by the Sheffield Food Bank Network.

We were also really pleased to be able to partner with First Buses to provide a Christmas Lunch Hamper to many of our clients. This was very gratefully received and came as a big relief to many people.

September 2022, saw us relocate back to our old premises at Roche Meeting Rooms in Westfield. For the previous 2 years, we had operated out of the Westfield Community Centre, which we were invited to use during the COVID Lockdowns. However, due to the Community Centre's activities returning back to normal, we were asked to vacate this space. We therefore approached Sheffield City Council to see if we could return to our old premises, which they kindly agreed to, at no cost to the Charity. This was a big effort but thanks to our amazing team of volunteers it went relatively

smoothly. The move has necessitated a few changes to our operating practices but these seem to have gone OK. On the whole it feels like the move has been a positive one for us and our clients.

September 2022 also saw us launch a partnership with a number of organisations to deliver a 'one stop shop' advice service for local residents to access support and advice for a range of different matters. The partners involved are:

Citizens Advice Sheffield, providing general and financial advice

Sheffield City Council, providing housing and general advice

Manor & Castle Development Trust, providing employment advice

Sheffield Futures, providing employment advice for young people aged 16-24

Woodhouse & District Community Forum Social Prescribers, providing advice related to health and wellbeing.

This has proved to be a very successful provision and one that we are actively looking to continue.

## Challenges & Responses to the Challenges

Without doubt the biggest challenge for us this year has, unsurprisingly been the Cost of Living crisis and the impact that this has had on the demand for our services. As mentioned above we have seen a 30% increase in the number of food parcels distributed. This has increased the strain on our volunteers and the volume of food that has to come in and go out of the Food Bank. We have been fortunate enough to pick up quite a few new volunteers this year but will need to increase our team further in the coming months if the demand continues to grow.

In addition to this, we are now beginning to spend more of our financial reserves on food supplies to resource our food parcels. We are fortunate that we currently have the financial reserves to do this, due to grants that we have received in previous years. We enter 2023/24 in a reasonably healthy financial state but we will need to explore further funding opportunities in order to keep pace with our current spending, if we are to still be a going concern at the end of 2023/24. We also need to look at additional sources of food donations, to reduce the amount that we need to spend per week. This is something that the Trustees are aware of and are actively looking at.

#### **Public Benefit**

We have endeavoured at all times to follow the objectives of the charity in order to ensure that all activities engaged in are for the public benefit.

#### **Financial Review**

The Charity does not currently have a reserves policy. This is due to the fact that we do not currently have any regular outgoings that we are committed to. The only money we really spend is on food purchases and small incidental expenses related to phone and internet which can be cancelled at a month's notice. Therefore, if the money of the charity were to ever run out to the point where we couldn't continue, we would just have to close the operation down. We are actively working to ensure that is not the case but we do not have any outgoings that would have to be met if that were the case.

#### In Conclusion

Historically we have not been the busiest of Food Banks, however, this has increased substantially since 2020. The number of parcels delivered per week is on average more than double what it was in the financial year 2019/20.

We continue to do our very best to meet the immediate needs of our clients and to provide as much signposting towards additional help with the root causes of their crises as we possibly can. However, it is heartbreaking to see the same people return week after week, month after month as there seems to be very little change in their circumstances. We do our best to treat our clients with dignity and respect as they navigate their way through these difficult times and wish there was more that we can do to help them.

The Trustees would like to express their sincere thanks to all volunteers and donors who have made our work possible.

We look forward to the day when our service can close due no longer being needed and continue to strive towards the day when this can be the case. Although, sadly this does seem further away than it ever has at this moment in time

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# Financial Statement for the year ending 31st March 2023

Year 7, done! It was a busy one as was suspected considering the level of inflation, especially in food and energy. Turnover was up by just less than 50% with expenditure rising by well over 50%, leaving a net deficit of £3.4k on the year.

Food donations in cash value were up by 20% with distribution up by 33%, which says it all. Fuel support payments rose from £60 to £650 year on year. Grants increased as more were sought to supply the demand on spending. A new venture this year was the inclusion of CAB support and funding was received to cover the cost of this provision. £625 of this remains for part of the final quarter payment due in June 2023. Insurance was also purchased independantly for the first time, instead of relying on the Ecclesiastical Insurance for St Mark's Church. As the operation moved premises in September 2022 a laptop, printer and internet provision were required to enable everything to run efficiently.

Once again we are indebted to our band of hard working volunteers, without whom the charity could not operate.

As the turnover of the charity once more exceeds £25,000 this year, an independent examination of the accounts is required. This will be done in accordance to the Charity Commission guidance notes in due course and the resulting report will be attached to the Charity's Annual Returns.


