In furtherance of these objects but not otherwise, the Trustees shall have power:

To establish or secure the establishment of a community centre and to maintain or manage or co-operate with any statutory authority in the maintenance and management of such a centre for activities promoted by the charity in furtherance of the above objects.

The Trustees hire facilities to around 20+ different groups for activities available to residents of Lisvane and the neighbourhood. These include a community library, photography group, computer group, an education initiative for dyslexic children, parent and toddler groups, Asian dance groups, exercise classes, dance groups for children, yoga, accommodation for volunteers who work in environmental groups, and casual bookings for children's birthday parties etc. The facilities are also used by the Lisvane Community Council.

In carrying out these activities, the Trustees had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit. They believe that the wide range of social, recreational and educational activities taking place in the centre, combined with the relatively low rents charged and the fact that the centre is available to all who wish to use it are consistent with the public benefit requirement.

Following substantial redevelopment of the building in 2021, the centre re-opened to the public in February 2022 with an official opening event in May 2022. Since then the centre has been a very busy focal point of the community. Part of the building has been sublet to a café which is open to the public 6 days a week.
