The objects of the charity are

In the interests of social welfare, to improve the conditions of life of the inhabitants of the parish of St Erme, Cornwall. Without distinction of political, religious or other opinions by the provision and maintenance of:

- A Sports and Community Centre for the use of inhabitants, including use for:
 - Meetings, lectures and classes
 - > Other forms of recreation and leisure-time occupation
 - A recreation ground for use by the inhabitants

Summary of the main activities undertaken for the benefit in relation to these objects

The Community Larder.:

This was started in response to the Covid outbreak in 2020 when the Parish Emergency Plan was put in place. The Trust joined in relief work with the Parish Council but after the pandemic receded and life got back to normal the cost - of living crisis indicated an on-going need in the village and this small food bank continued to help assist people with difficulties.

The offer to users needed to be amended because of experience over the 2 years of Covid. It was open to all, without assessment, like other similar larders locally and a membership scheme was started to help with administration. Our records indicate that our users were local with a wide spread of ages and a large proportion of working families.

An improved supply line with FareShare helped with supply and we continued to collect from supermarkets such as M&S and Lidl and also ALDI later on in 2022. Some extra provision was made for children's needs using some small specific grants.

The Trust obtained a grant of £6000 from the Cornwall Community Foundation to assist with the purchase of some food stocks to maintain supply. Most of this was spent by the end of the year. Careful stewardship of the grant monies and donations has allowed continuation of the Community Larder which provides clear benefit to members of the community who may find themselves with difficulty.

General Review

The focus continues to be on community activity in line with our original Trust deed.

A key feature of the Community Centre site is the larger cricket field to the north and the football pitch on the south side.

Close liaison is maintained with the sports clubs that use the facility.

St Erme Football Club continued to play regularly and other local clubs such as Truro Youth FC and Truro Grasshoppers have played here. Towards the end of the year a new venture, based in the village, that aimed to bring football coaching to early primary school age children started to use our facility. This venture – Trispen Tigers, is focussing on children in the village.

The cricket club now runs 3 teams and is in the top league division and runs weekly training sessions for children and young people.

Regular hall hire has stabilised over the year, with users including fitness organisations, parts of the NHS, Blood Donors and community groups and organisations carrying out regular training sessions. There were bookings for private parties and events.

We continue to allow discounts for local and charitable bodies. The Centre is used for Parish Council Meetings and the Cornwall Councillor's regular surgeries as well as public consultation events. The Centre is the venue for the St Erme Fun Day which took place in July.

The bar was open at weekends and there were some regular music and entertainment events although less than in past years as we have needed to review costs and attendance.

All of the above were part of our commitment to community benefit.

The work to replace two old pieces of equipment at Trencreek Park children's play park were completed in this year although there are still some issues to complete and further maintenance to the site will be needed. This has been part of the Trust activity for over 20 years.

The Trustees have continued to review operations and finance because of the changing economic climate.

In the longer term we would still like to add an indoor sports hall, additional changing rooms and the possibility of acquiring further land for a 3G pitch but in the light of increasing costs and the need to focus on other issues, this is still deferred for the time being.

The need for installation electric vehicle charging points that are available to all has continued to be on our agenda this year. Many people in the village will not be able to charge at home and with our site being easily available to the public, there could be a clear public benefit in following this matter up. The financing could be complicated this will be an on-going discussion as the position evolves.

During the year, some of our policies were reviewed and some renewal of our training for Trustees took place.

Safeguarding was always on the agenda and remains a constant consideration.

Achievements and performance

It is good to see the regular hall hire and the way that the income has supported our operations and the 10% increase in rates has not been detrimental. This is a comfort in the light of the sharp rise in energy prices.

The increased sporting activity is a key feature.

The need to support others in the village is still in focus and the Emergency Plan work still goes on but at a more modest level.

Structure and Financial review

Our accounts show that the net unrestricted cash funds this year stand at £ but as they are prepared on a 'Receipts and Payment' basis some further detail is needed.

Overall, there are some large differences in the detail compared with 2022 and these reflect the move away from the covid emergency period and the onset of the energy and economic difficulties.

Income.

Hire income rose to £37076 and this may be due to the further recovery from the covid period and a 10% rise in rates. The regular users of the Centre, many of whom are from the NHS and other health organisations have stayed loyal and we are grateful for this.

The return of the gift-aided profits from St Erme Playing Fields Ltd, that runs the bar and catering, after a two - year gap, gave us £12194.

Fund raising was higher than last year with total receipts of £9545 helped by a successful Bonfire Night at £2919 that was probably down to the good reputation of the display and the demise of other nearby events. Bingo receipts were also up at £1981.

Expenditure.

following the expiry of our fixed rate deal in December 2021. The rate rose to a point where we were advised of some 58p/unit coming but managed to get a fixed rate of 32.9p to June 2024. There has been little support under the government schemes as we had a fixed rate organised. As reported last year there was a carry forward of

some £5000 in un-billed electricity costs and this, together with a period at flexible rates has caused the figure to be high.

Water costs have also gone up, together with the waste collection costs.

Insurances and licences are higher. The insurance costs went up slightly and the entertainment licences were paid for the previous two years - £1729. This was carried forward from last year as there was a review of the system.

Maintenance is higher. The largest item is the cost of a new safety fence for the football field - £3454, which was covered by a grant from some S106 funds via Comwall Council.

Restricted Funds

These are for various purposes and some extra detail is set out below:

Christmas Lights 2022- £135.05 was given and the costs this year amounted to £434.01.

Sowenna Appeal - £204.35 was donated at various functions. The fund now stands at £2107.11

Trencreek Park improvements – Grants totalling £9423.80 were received and £10310.80 was spent.

Community Larder - £1679.43 was received from local people and organisations. New Score Box – Funds were paid by the cricket club to cover material, costs (£1142.46) and £923.73 was paid from our own resources to purchase a new shutter window.

Trencreek Park Maintenance – The spend was £450.80 and £400 was held from 2021/22 with another £400 received this year.

Cost Recovery – In addition to the funds seen for the new score box, £4806.72 was received from St Erme Playing Fields Ltd to cover wages that are due to the company.

Statement of the charity's policy on reserves

The trust has a Reserves Policy to ensure that the future needs are considered for maintenance, contingencies and risk management. This is reviewed regularly and a constant tally has been made of overheads during the year, underlining the need to maintain a Reserve figure of £25000. This was revised in the light of the energy costs.

Summary

The regular hall hire through functions is key and we will need to maintain this.
