- Promoting knowledge and mutual understanding and respect of the beliefs and practices of different religious faiths.


The trustees confirm that they have complied with their duty regard to the guidance on public benefit published by the Charity Commission in exercising their powers of duties.

Achievements and performance


The Harmony Initiative continues to promote religious harmony on its social media channels.


