OVER 150 FAMILIES WERE SUPPORTED WITH FOOD PACKS EVERY MONTH. 20 POOR WOMEN WERE SUPPORTED WITH SEWING MACHINE GRANTS TO ESTABLISH A LIVELIHOOD AND 19 HANDPUMPS WERE INSTALLED IN POOR PEOPLE AREAS BENEFITTING THE LOCAL COMMUNITIES WITH CLEAN WATER. THE TRUSTEES HAVE HAD DUE REGARD TO THE GUIDANCE ISSUED BY THE CHARITY COMMISSION ON PUBLIC BENEFIT AND ARE SATISFIED THAT THEY ARE ADVANCING EDUCATION AND RELIEVING FINANCIAL HARDSHIP FOR PUBLIC BENEFIT.

THIS GENERATED A SURPLUS WHICH WAS RETAINED MAINLY FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE PROJECTS. THE RESERVES OF THE CHARITY WERE £1,099 AT YEAR END. THE POLICY OF THE TRUSTEES IS NOT TO HOLD ANY RESERVES BUT TO USE ANY SURPLUS OR RESERVES FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE.
