#### INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH 2023

I report on the accounts of Madonna House (United Kingdom) for the year ended 31st March 2023, which are set out on pages 1 to 2.

#### Respective Responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The charity's trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144 of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed.

## It is my responsibility to:

### Basis of the Independent Examiner's Report
