The charity has seen the strong relationship with the Thurrock Council continue this year. It also has continued to maintain a strong relationship with the Thurrock Council Community Development Manager.

As the councils contact for the faith sector Transformation Thurrock help awareness raising of the resident support resources in the faith sector, especially the Warmer Spaces initiative.

The weekly Thurrock Leaders Prayer meeting has continued either as a virtual meeting and later in the year as a hybrid meeting. The venue continued to rotate around churches in Thurrock.

Transformation Thurrock is the representative organisation for Thurrock Essex East London Churches Together.

The charity has facilitated the formation of Thurrock Street Pastors with the forming of a board of trustees and additional management members.
