# Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of the Doctors' Support Network

I report on the accounts of the charity for the year ended 30 June 2023 which are set out on pages 3 to 8.

#### Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the terms of the Charities and Trustee Investment (Scotland) Act 2005 and the Charities Accounts (Scotland) Regulations 2006 (as amended). The charity trustees consider that the audit requirement of Regulation 10(1) (d) of the 2006 Accounts Regulations does not apply. #### Basis of independent examiner's statement
