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### REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES

### FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2015

The trustees present its report and the independently examined financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2015.

#### Activities

The charity exists to provide a community centre for the residents of Allington situated at Castle Road, Maidstone, Kent ME16 OPZ. The centre provides a number of social and recreational facilities for residents and fulfils a function as a focal point for the community that it serves.

### Objects

The trustees continues to work towards ensuring that the community centre building is kept in good repair and compliant with current Health and Safety regulations, to adhere to the Association constitution.

#### Review of business

An overview of the financial position of the Charity for the last financial year shows that the association has maintained viability in a difficult period, during which increased maintenance took place and amid increasing costs for services.

### Future strategy

The charity plans continuing activities as outlined above in the forthcoming years subject to satisfactory funding arrangements.

### Reserves policies

The trustees have established a policy whereby unrestricted funds will be used to finance ongoing building repair and maintenance and improvements programme, essential to the continued existence of the Community Association.

### Trustees

All trustees are appointed at an Annual General Meeting by a vote.

### Responsibilities of the trustees

The trustees are responsible for preparing financial statements for each financial year which give a true and fair view of the state of the affairs of the charity as at the balance sheet date and of its incoming resources and application of resources, including income and expenditure, for the financial year. In preparing those financial statements, the trustees should follow best practice and:

- select suitable accounting policies and apply them consistently;
- make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and
- prepare the financial statements on the going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to assume that the charity will continue on that basis.
