Gifts in kind are accounted for at a reasonable estimate of their value to the charity or the amount actually realised.

Gifts in kind for sale or distribution are included in the accounts as gifts only when sold or distributed by the charity.

Gifts in kind for use by the charity are included in the SoFA as incoming resources when receivable.

Donated services and facilities

These are only included in incoming resources (with an equivalent amount in resources expended) where the benefit to the charity is reasonably quantifiable, measurable and material. The value placed on these resources is the estimated value to the charity of the service or facility received.

Volunteer help

The value of any voluntary help received is not included in the accounts but is described in the trustees' annual report.

Investment income

This is included in the accounts when receivable.

Investment gains and losses This includes any gain or loss on the sale of investments and any gain or loss resulting from revaluing investments to market value at the end of the year.

EXPENDITURE AND LIABILITIES

Liability recognition

Liabilities are recognised as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to pay out resources.

Grants with performance conditions

Southampton Musical Society, also known as 'SMS' was formed in 1928. It is registered charity number 299426.

The charity has no office as such and is based at: 10 The Saplings, Holbury, Southampton, Hampshire, SO45 2QP for financial purposes.

The Society has 4 trustees known as 'officers' as at approval of the annual report those in office were Mr. M Barton-Leigh, Ms S. Radley, Mrs. E. Iles and Mrs. L.W. Conway. Those 'officers' positions are Chairman, Business Manager, Honorary Secretary and Treasurer.

The Society appoints its 'officers' and 4 members to its Committee. On alternate years 2 officers and 2 committee members are appointed by vote at the Annual General Meeting. The Society has a Constitution and Rules that have been approved at the Annual General Meeting.

During 2015 Southampton Musical Society performed productions of Our House and West End Exchange at The Berry Theatre, Hedge End. The principal objects of the Society include education of the public in the dramatic and operatic arts, as well as furthering the development of public appreciation and taste in the said arts and to assist and further such charitable institutions and charitable purposes as the Committee shall from time to time determine.
