#### Report of the Trustees for Year Ending 31st March 2016

#### Summary of Activities

One property was vacant for four months all the other Almshouses have been fully occupied throughout the year. The resident's contributions amounted to £19,633. The Trustees have reviewed the Resident's Contributions as in the previous year and no increase has been made therefore the contribution will stay at £50.00 per week until 31/3/16

A review will be carried out prior to 2017.

The operating costs were £19,808 making the comparative operating cost higher than the previous two years, this was due to increased costs on repairs & maintainence for the properties . Loan repayments amounted to £5,416, purchase of investments to £1,600. Moneys spent on ramp access project amounted to £1,125 and miscellaneous payments to £160. Leaving a surplus of £2,680 between income and expenditure. The closing bank balance stands at £28,402

#### Risk Management

The Trustees have examined the major strategic, business and operational risks which the Charity faces and confirm that systems have been established to enable the Charity to lessen or mitigate those risks.

#### **Appointment of Trustees**

No more than seven members make up the Register of Trustees. Three Trustees are appointed by the Parish Council, three are nominated by the other Trustees and the seventh is always the Vicar of Wye or his representative. Normally when a Trustee retires a new one is appointed as soon as possible however there may be a gap of a few months before this is can be achieved.
